

## Honors in BIS Application

### To be eligible to apply students must:

- Have an approved BIS Educational Contract with a Faculty Mentor
- Have accumulated at least 90 credit hours upon entering Honors in BIS
- Have a cumulative Mason grade point average of at least 3.75
- Have completed ENGL 302 with a grade of B+ or higher
- Have no honor code violations on his/her academic record
- Have completed (or will be taking) research methods course relevant to BIS concentration
- Have six or fewer credits remaining in BIS concentration, not counting BIS core courses
- Be willing to commit to two consecutive semesters of coursework and completion of a research project (BIS 391/BIS 490-BIS 491)

### Application requirements:

- Honors in BIS Application, to be completed by student
- Faculty Mentor Recommendation Form, to be submitted by faculty directly to BIS Office
- **DUE:** Submission of Application and Faculty Mentor Recommendation Form to BIS Office, Enterprise Hall Room 352, MSN 5A9, during the **semester prior** to enrolling in BIS 391
