### IMPORTANT ACADEMIC POLICIES TO REMEMBER:

1. Written Communications requirements (ENGL101 and ENGL302) must be passed with a grade of "C" or better.
2. The 60 credits in the major must be completed with a minimum GPA of 2.00.
3. A minimum of 30 credit hours MUST be completed at GMU, which MUST include 12 credits within the major.
4. A minimum of 45 credit hours of Upper Level (300 to 499) course work must be completed.
5. **PHED101-200, 202-299, 380-389; PRLS101-209, 211-299; and MLSC 100-399** courses **cannot** be used towards a CHSS degree.
6. A minimum of 120 credits is required for graduation, with a minimum GPA of 2.0
