- 3. No more than 12 credits of CRIM 485 Study Abroad can be applied to the major.
- 4. A minimum of 30 credit hours must be completed at GMU, including 12 credits within the major.
- **5.** A minimum of 45 credit hours of upper level (300-499) course work must be completed.
- 6. A maximum of 3 credits of 100-level RECR coursework may satisfy the degree requirements (as general elective).
- 7. MLSC courses at the 400-level can be used toward a CHSS degree; credit for other MLSC courses may not be used.
- 8. A minimum of 120 credits is required for graduation, with a minimum overall GPA of 2.0
