2. Students pursuing this degree must complete 60 credits within the major, with a minimum GPA of 2.00.
3. A minimum of 30 credit hours must be completed at GMU, including 12 credits within the major.
4. A maximum of 3 credits of 100-level RECR coursework may satisfy general electives. No PHED or PRLS courses can be applied towards the degree.
5. MLSC 400-level courses can be used toward a CHSS degree; credit for other MLSC courses may not be used.
6. CHSS foreign language proficiency must be demonstrated through the intermediate level. GAA waiver does not satisfy the language requirement. Waiver possible -- see <http://mcl.gmu.edu/placement-testing> for information.
