



2020 Vernon Smith Essay Contest

The Economics Department is sponsoring the Vernon Smith Essay Contest with a first-place award of \$500 and a second-place award of \$250. The Contest is open to all undergraduates enrolled in any 100 level Economics class during the Spring Semester. Prior award winners are ineligible for this contest. To enter this contest, students must write an economics essay discussing the topic:

Has the case for socialism been refuted?

Please include the following in your essay:

- Name, G Number, and email address on the top right of the first page, include your name on each subsequent page
- Times New Roman 12-point font
- 5-7 pages or 2,000 words
- Submit 1 copy of the essay. Essays will be evaluated for their cogency, economic reasoning, and persuasiveness.

UPDATE TO DUE DATE AND SUBMISSION METHOD: In consideration of the extended spring break, submit essays **by email** (attached essay to email, in PDF or MS Word format) to mbernier@gmu.edu no later than **March 20th, 2020 before 5:00 PM, EST.**
