- If you have completed testing and you are waiting for your results/report, please contact your assigned examiner to arrange for a phone/virtual feedback session.
- **Beginning Monday, March 23rd, in-person therapy sessions will be suspended. Current therapy clients will have the option of continuing to meet with their therapists virtually.** Please contact your therapist directly to make arrangements.
