## Japanese placement questions:

- 1. Are you able to read and write the Japanese alphabets, Hiragana and Katakana?
- 2. Are you able to introduce yourself briefly in Japanese using the polite speech style?
- 3. Are you able to talk about routine and future actions in Japanese using polite present form of verbs and appropriate particles (に、を、へ、で、と)?
- 4. Are you able to talk about past actions and events in Japanese using the polite past form of verbs?
- 5. Are you able to make sentences by connecting verb and adjective phrases and sentences in Japanese using the  $\mathcal{T}$ -form of verbs and adjectives?
- 6. Are you able to read and write 25 or more kanji?

If you answered 'yes,' to the above questions #1-6, you may register for JAPA201.

- 7. Are you able to talk about your likes and dislikes in Japanese using すき or きらい, and make comparisons using いちばん,  $\sim$ ほうが,  $\sim$ より, and  $\sim$ も $\sim$ も?
- 8. Are you able to express desire in Japanese using  $\mathbb{E} \cup \mathbb{N}$  and  $\sim \mathcal{E} \mathbb{N}$ ?
- 9. Are you able to express quantities with numbers and counters in Japanese using まい, 本, ひき, さつ and Japanese origin numbers  $\sim >?$
- 10. Are you able to read and write 75 or more kanji?

If you answered 'yes,' to the above questions #1-10, you may register for JAPA 202.

- 11. Are you able to introduce your family and describe them in Japanese in terms of their clothing, physical appearance and skills?
- 12. Are you able to express your opinions in Japanese using the dictionary/informal form of verbs + おもいます?
- 13. Are you able to talk about routine, past and future activities and events in Japanese using the casual form?
- 14. Are you able to read and write 120 or more kanji?

If you answered 'yes,' to the above questions #1-14, you may register for JAPA 330.
