Academic Standing

The updated policy of academic progress became effective in Fall 2022 and applies to all undergraduate degree and nondegree students at Mason. Academic standing is based on both the cumulative GPA and the GPA at the end of an academic period.

As of Fall 2022, in order to meet the Qualitative Standard of Satisfactory Academic Progress, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 must be maintained (for undergraduate students).
