## **Notes:**

Most thesis projects take at least two semesters to complete with the typical schedule being fall to spring. Students can start during other semesters with prior approval from the department. Students <u>can</u> register for a single semester (3 credit hours) to receive credit for a capstone course and credit in the major. However, for students pursuing departmental honors in economics, they <u>must</u> register for two semesters (6 credit hours) to be eligible. Also, these hours must be in addition to the all the requirements for the economics major and they cannot count as major electives to receive that recognition.
