When choosing courses for your contract and selecting a concentration title, consider these questions to help guide you:

Concentration requirements

- A concentration consists of 21 credits from a minimum of 2 disciplines - *in addition* to the 13 credits of required BIS core courses (BIS 300, 301, 390, 490).
- At least 15 credits must be upper-level (300 – 400) with no more than 12 credits at the graduate level (500 – 600).
- No more than 15 credits of previously earned or nontraditional credit from institutions outside Mason.
- The total credits applied to the concentration must equal a minimum GPA of 2.00.

Important note: All students must meet the university requirements of 45 upper-level, 30 residency, and 120 total credits.
