FOLK 799: Thesis

Students in the Folklore concentration will take 30 credits in coursework that explores folklore both globally and locally, both contemporary and historical folk cultures. In addition to cousework, faculty regularly receive grants for folklore research in which you will have an opportunity to participate. Mason's folklore program collaborates with the Library of Congress each year on the Field School for Cultural Documentation. Here, you will learn how to complete a professional ethnographic project by working in investigative teams to document a local community. The program prepares students for careers in cultural agencies, governmental organizations, and education, as well as advanced study in the humanities.
